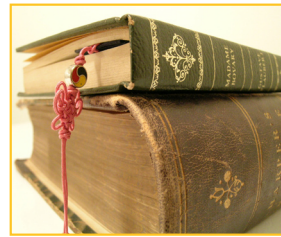




A partnership to develop successful readers... a successful community.
